Frequently Asked Questions

Do you have a café?

We don't have a cafe onsite, but there are many family-friendly cafes and restaurants in Lewisham Shopping Centre and the surrounding area.

Can I bring my own food?

We do not allow food and drink inside our galleries, but there are benches right outside the museum where you can eat and drink. These benches are located inside the shopping centre in Central Square, so are protected from the weather and usable all year round.

Is there somewhere to leave my buggy?

Please ask a member of staff who will direct you to an appropriate place to leave your buggy.

Do you have toilets?

There are public toilets inside Lewisham Shopping Centre, a 1-minute walk away from the museum.

Is there somewhere I can breastfeed?
